Rev. Simon Goddard Simon was previously involved in starting an ecumenical fresh expression near Cambridge, UK. He then served for 4½ years as a regional minister for the Eastern Baptist Association with oversight of more than 60 churches. For the last three years he has been one of two national Pioneer Co-ordinators for the Baptist Union of Great Britain, and recently became part of the new Fresh Expressions leadership community. He was part of a 'classic' msm course team for a number of years as well as having pioneered the online version of the msm course. As team leader for fx resourcing he project managed the launch of the Godsend app and is now responsible for facilitating the resourcing of the fx movement He is married to Lisa, was recently professed as a Third Order Franciscan, and is co-author of the book 'Big Hearted: the Gospel of Simple Words and a Large Heart'.

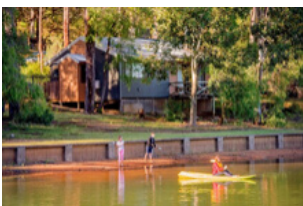
Rev Dr Adam McIntosh
